Randy: Equipment will be hard to come by, is there a pared down route?, Loretta is initiating the EOC, inquired about is there is a CERT team. Chief Sexton advised yes, and that we have 5 radios available to them. Recommended reaching out to outside resources as well such as timber companies.

Discussion on if backhoes would be available, what that might look like for contracting.
