Treasurer's Report/Payment of Bills and Payroll:

Total of \$50,455.65 bills and payroll for the month of October.

Chiefs Report:

- 58 calls in October, to include one structure fire.
- We moved forward with signing a contract with Vector/Target Solutions to help provide and track trainings for our personnel.
- IV Tech Class just ended. Total of 18 in class, 17/18 finished successfully, the last will test later due to an emergency.
- Bradley Air: We will start doing our own L&I paperwork for any work they do for compliance for prevailing wage standard, so they don't charge us extra for that.
- October 31, 2022 was the end of the vaccine mandate: Commissioners agree with suggesting the covid vaccine, and educating on the benefits, otherwise providing a waiver.

Old Business:

- Skokomish Tribe Contract is scheduled to be on the agenda for November, so we are waiting to hear the outcome.
- Lt. Pyle put in for a grant with DNR for a truck. They have 17 trucks that are being offered. They

- A-18-1 work has been completed.
- Hoodsport Flooring: Commissioner McDougall is reaching out to someone to come look at the condition and make suggestions on how best to move forward with repairs.
- WSRB: We are in the process of disputing the draft form.
- 2023 budget: Reviewed the budget work done so far, looking at options for priority of the 1, 3, 5, 10+ year list. Looking at options for Air Conditioning for Station 18-1, Commissioners suggested having it done all at once, rather than look at doing it in sections.
